

Bio-Physical Evaluation of Different Milks from Indian Animals

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The densities, viscosities, refractive indices, and speeds of sound of milks from different animals in India have been measured. The above physical properties have been correlated with the fat and non-fat concentrations in the milks. The spoiling of milk has been detected by speed of sound measurements. Both biological and physical aspects of different Indian milks have been studied on the basis of the above measurements, and the results are presented graphically.
